Supervisor Manwarren asked everyone to stand for the Pledge to the Flag. After the Pledge, Mr. Manwarren asked for a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of interviewing candidates for the existing open positions. Ms. Fairbanks made a motion to go into Executive Session. Mrs. Ciborowski seconded the motion. The Board was polled and the motion was passed with three yeases and no nos. One Councilperson's seat was vacant and Mr. Collier was absent. The Board went into Executive Session at 5:35pm.

Ms. Fairbanks made a motion to come out of Executive Session. Mrs. Ciborowski seconded the motion. The Board was polled and the motion was passed with three yeases and no nos. One Councilperson's seat was vacant and Mr. Collier was absent. The Board came out of Executive Session at 7:35pm.

Ms. Fairbanks read and moved Resolution #7 Appointing Harold Cole as Town Enforcement Officer. Mrs. Ciborowski seconded the Resolution. The Board was polled and the Resolution was passed with three yeses and no nos. One Councilperson's seat was vacant and Mr. Collier was absent.

Mr. Manwarren read Resolution #8 To Appoint A Council Member to Fill The Vacant Position on the Town Council. The Resolution included the appointment of Mrs. Tameka Leib as Town Council Member. Mrs. Ciborowski made a motion to adopt the Resolution. Ms. Fairbanks seconded the motion. The Board was polled and the Resolution was passed with three yeses and no nos. One Councilperson's seat was vacant and Mr. Collier was absent.

Mr. Redenback presented the Board with three quotes for a truck he said was needed by the Highway. Mrs. Ciborowski read the first one from Matthews Ford in Norwich. The quote was for \$50,759.43 after all discounts and the trade in were considered. She read the quote from Friendly's which was \$51,000.00 for the same truck. Friendly's quote on a 2025 Dodge Ram truck was \$52,349.50 after discounts and the trade in. Discussion followed. Mrs. Ciborowski made a motion to accept the bid from Matthews Ford in Norwich for \$50,759.43. Ms. Fairbanks seconded the motion. The Board was polled and the motion was passed with three yeses and no nos. One Councilperson's Seat was vacant and Mr. Collier was absent.

The question was asked about the consecutive number of the Resolutions. Mr. Manwarren accounted for each one.

Mr. Wightman asked for clarification about the salary payments made to Mr. Marshall and Mr. Redenback at the end of and the beginning of the year. Mr. Manwarren said he would clarify the issue with the bookkeeper.

Mr. Manwarren reminded everyone that the next meeting will be on February 9, 2026 at 6:30pm.

Mrs. Ciborowski made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Fairbanks seconded the motion. The Board was polled and the motion was passed with three yeases and no nos. One Councilperson's seat was vacant and Mr. Collier was absent. The meeting was adjourned at 7:50pm.
