Town of Plymouth Resolution to Rescind Resolution No. 20 of 2025

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 20 of 2025 requires the Highway Superintendent to submit a monthly fuel report; and
WHEREAS, the Town has determined that the current fuel-tracking system produces inaccurate and unreliable data; and
WHEREAS, the Town Board is not comfortable requiring the Highway Superintendent to file reports that are known to be inaccurate or misleading; and
WHEREAS, the Town Board intends to implement a new and improved tracking system in the future, at which time such reporting requirements will be reinstated;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Plymouth hereby rescinds Resolution No. 20 of 2025 in its entirety; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board will revisit and re-establish a monthly fuel-reporting requirement once a new tracking system has been installed and proven effective.
